## History – I am Warrior!

The Romans have landed! This term we will be learning about this civilisations and the legacy they have left behind. We will be comparing them to the Celts and by using sources to research their daily lives including: food, clothing, entertainment, school, architecture and their very well organised army!

### Science - Sound

# Computing
